1. The **Mongolia** has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of **Improving Access to Health Services for Disadvantaged Groups Investment Program - Tranche 1**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
2. The **Ministry of Health** (“the Purchaser”) invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the **Supply of Medical Equipment for Emergency Medical Service**.
3. Open competitive bidding – International will be conducted in accordance with ADB’s [Single-Stage: One-Envelope Bidding Procedure](#) and is open to all bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the Bidding Document may participate in this bidding:
 - a) **Pending Litigation and Arbitration:**

All pending litigation, arbitration or other material events impacting the net worth and/or liquidity of the bidder, if any, shall be treated as resolved against the Bidder and so shall in total not represent more than 50 percent of the Bidder’s net worth calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities.
 - b) **Contractual Experience:**

Successful completion as main supplier within the last three (3) years, of at least three (3) contracts each valued at USD 1,200,000 with nature, and complexity similar to the scope of supply of medical equipment.

c) Technical Experience:

The Bidder shall demonstrate that the goods offered have

- (i) been in production for at least 3 years, and
- (ii) been sold a minimum of 3 units of similar type and specification over the last three (3) years (2023, 2024, 2025);
- (iii) been in operation for a minimum of three (3) years (2023, 2024, 2025).

d) Historical Financial Performance:

Submission of audited financial statements or, if not required by the law of the Bidder's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Purchaser, for the last three (3) years (2023, 2024, 2025) to demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's financial position. As a minimum, the Bidder's net worth for the last year calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities should be positive.

e) Size of Operation (Average Annual Turnover):

Minimum average annual turnover of **USD 3,000,000** calculated as total payments received by the Bidder for contracts completed or under execution over the last three (3) years (2023, 2024, 2025).

f) Cash Flow Capacity:

Availability of or access to liquid assets, lines of credit, and other finances sufficient to meet cash flow requirement which is **USD 500,000**.

g) Personnel Requirements:

The Bidder shall employ a minimum of five (5) well-trained Biomedical Engineers who have completed training in the maintenance, operation, and technical servicing of Intensive Care and Emergency Medical Equipment. Each engineer must have at least five (5) years of relevant professional experience in the field of Biomedical Equipment, with a particular focus on Intensive Care and Emergency Medical Equipment. All engineers shall hold, at a minimum, a Bachelor's degree in Biomedical and Electronics Engineering or an equivalent or higher qualification. Notarized copies of each Engineer's educational diploma and training certificates, along with official translations, shall be submitted as part of the bid.
